



## Kurnell Community Update, 22 July 2022

Dear Kurnell Community,

See below an update on ongoing operations at Ampol's Kurnell Terminal.

### Community Working Groups

We are pleased to share that all three community working groups (CWGs) have started with initial establishment meetings taking place over the last few weeks. Thank you to the 16 community members that are participating.

Future meeting topics were discussed and agendas for these meetings will be shared with members prior to each meeting. Minutes will be taken, by the independent secretariat, at all CWG meetings. The minutes will be made available to the broader community via the Ampol website as part of a commitment to transparency by the group.

The purpose of the Ampol Kurnell Terminal CWGs is to enable the community to receive clear information, ask questions and keep up to date on matters that relate to Ampol Kurnell Terminal operations impacting the local community; including but not limited to remediation activities to address odours, Ampol emergency response procedures and community investment plans.

Community members will be representing the Kurnell community with the expectation they will share information and seek input from the broader Kurnell community. The CWGs are also an opportunity to ensure local knowledge and perspectives inform Ampol Kurnell Terminal operations.

### Validation testing on website

As previously communicated, remediation works following the overflow incident have now been completed. Validation testing results from soil samples for final works in zones 1 to 7 have now been posted to the Ampol website - <https://www.ampol.com.au/about-ampol/news-and-media/kurnell-update>. This is a preliminary presentation of the results which will be formally reported in a future and final validation report. When available, the validation report will be presented to the Remediation Community Working Group and posted to our website.
